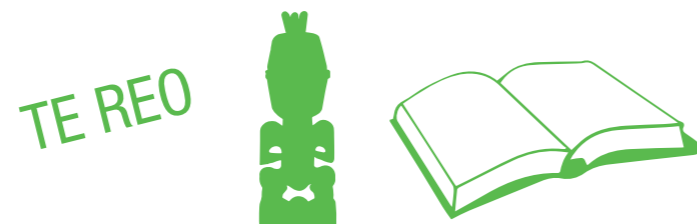

WHAT THE SCHOOLS ARE SAYING...

“ One direct outcome of the breakfasts for students has been the impact on overall attendance which has risen to a 91% average for the past two terms - an 8% increase which can be directly attributed to the breakfast programme.

The second observation we're made is the reduction in the number of children who had been displaying undesirable behaviours. This of course allows teachers to get on with their primary role of teaching. ”
