









## THE PLAN...

In October 2013, after consultation with the Principal of Glen Innes School, a decision was made to invite 250 adults and children to a Christmas Banquet on the 23rd of December 2013.

A budget was created with assistance from Austin's Catering and New World Southmall, and set at \$2,500.00.

A Give-a-Little web page was created and emails sent out to supporters in an effort to raise the targeted budget.

Within three weeks, the target of \$2,500.00 was reached and within six weeks we reached \$3,400.00. A further \$1500.00 was donated directly to Breakfast Club, which enabled the quantity of the food to be increased, more presents to be purchased (and for the true running costs to be met).

## THE EVENT...

20 families attended - 260 adults and children.

Every family present received food and dessert hampers, Hubbards Cereal, and a gift bag of sweets. Every child under 12 years received a present.

There was sufficient food left over to give every family at least one two litre container of turkey, lamb and vegetables. We were also able to supply left over food for a Christmas Day lunch at St Columba Church and also to some families at Randwick Park, Manurewa.
